# Springing to Life in Lent

What then are we to say? Should we continue in sin in order that grace may abound? <sup>2</sup>By no means! How can we who died to sin go on living in it? <sup>3</sup>Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? <sup>4</sup>Therefore we have been buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.

<sup>5</sup>For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. <sup>6</sup>We know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be destroyed, and we might no longer be enslaved to

sin. <sup>7</sup>For whoever has died is freed from sin. <sup>8</sup>But if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him.

—Romans 6:1-7 (NRSV)

Likewise Lent is a time where we learn about our death and our new life in Christ. When we hear what Jesus will do for us on Good Friday, winter then be-

comes part of the process that brings the resurgence and life of Easter. The death is necessary but it brings the message of Easter which is one of life and new possibilities.

Every church needs new possibilities. With an Easter mindset we are convinced that God is working in new and unexpected ways. We are anticipating healing and hope in a world that is often clouded by pain, death and winter. And we can have confidence in this because our new life in Christ is happening now. It's not a reality for the distant future. Paul says in Romans 6 that sin and death no longer have dominion over

us. Instead, we live in the newness of grace and are alive to God in Christ Jesus. This new life is meant to be lived out in the world as God's new possibilities are seen in unexpected and life-changing ways.

May this promise lead us to be people of life and grace in the world.


We sincerely thank and appreciate all that Phil Sell and his crew have done to make this transformation. This could not have been accomplished without their time, talents, and dedication.

#### What's noteworthy?

At the end of February, year to date expenses exceeded income by \$4435. Note that in 2016 we were in a similar position. The situation will be monitored in the coming months with no specific action recommended at this time. Once a quarter the financial report will be included in a Sunday bulletin to provide greater visibility of the financial status to the congregation.

In February, we paid back \$70,000 of the \$100,000 loan taken in 2016 to help finance the roofing project. Mission Investment Fund has re-amortized our loan over the same period of time resulting in a decrease in our monthly mortgage payment from \$4232 to \$3685 effective April 1, 2017 (note: the payment was \$3902 prior to additional loan).

Thank you members and friends of Calvary for supporting the mission of our congregation with your hearts and your financial commitment.
