**P** <sup>36</sup>While they were talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." <sup>37</sup>They were startled and terrified, and thought that they were seeing a ghost. <sup>38</sup>He said to them, "Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? <sup>39</sup>Look at my hands and my feet; see that it is I myself. - The charts above show that net ordinary incomes for the months in the first quarter of 2018 closely match those of 2017, yielding a similar year-to-date (YTD) operating fund deficit. However, in the first quarter of 2018 monthly expenses were offset by monthly Steel Lake Presbyterian (SLP) building use fees, so actual 2018 YTD expenses were about \$5000 greater than indicated above. *(In the first quarter of 2017 SLP was not yet using the building.)*
