## What's noteworthy?

- In October 2018, expenses exceeded income by \$7,613, increasing the year-to-date (YTD) operating fund deficit to (\$14,171). Income for the month was much lower than average, while expenses were a bit higher than average.
- YTD income in 2017 was much higher than in 2018 while YTD expenses in 2017 were much lower than in 2018, yielding a large surplus last year and a large deficit this year.
- At the time of submission of this report, the November financials were not yet completed, but income for the first 3 weeks of the month has been above average. It is hoped that will reduce the YTD deficit.
