



- Rain Ponchos—one size fits all





UPDATE Reach Out Volunteers Needed

Calvary will be hosting the Reach Out program from Dec. 30th through March 1st. In Reach Out, up to 30 men are provided a hot meal and a warm, dry, safe place to sleep for the night. In addition to making our kitchen and social hall available each night, we are responsible to provide the following:

- (1) A host each evening (from 8:00-9:30 PM), whose duties are to let in the overnight supervisor and the team providing the evening's meal, make a pot of coffee and hot water, set out beverages and items needed to serve the dinner, and restock breakfast supplies.
- (2) Meal teams to make and serve dinners the week of February 16-23. Meals consist of a main dish, salad or vegetable, bread or rolls, and dessert.

This is Calvary's 12th year of participating in this program that is so vital to the homeless in our community. If you are willing to serve as a host or as part of a meal team, sign up on the sheets posted in the Narthex or contact Waverly Hagen at 253-939-9132 or awhagen@comast.net.

What's noteworthy?

- October's income was far below average and expenses a little above average, leading to an operating deficit of (\$10,116) for the month and increasing the year-to-date operating deficit to (\$25,007). (Monthly expenses and income over the last 3 years have averaged \$32,700 to \$33,700).
- The year-to-date deficit is significantly more than what it was in 2018 at this time.
- There are some large expenses still to come in before the end of the year: planned annual expenses of about \$10,300 (insurance premium, annual fire system inspection and backflow report) and \$6,900 in unplanned expenses (updates to fire alarm / suppression system, furnace repair, bi-fold door repair).
