Is This Enough?

"The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it." ~ John 1:5 (NRSV)

Happy New Year! Is it not astounding that 2019 has arrived?!?

While I must admit any time of year is the proper time to think

about what God is doing in our midst, I feel a special pull on my heart to slow down and truly wrestle with the question as we fly, head-first, into 2019.

So, what is God doing in and around Calvary Lutheran Church in Federal Way, WA? In many ways I love this

question. It proclaims loudly that God is active in our lives, here and now! But, I also find myself dreading to interact with such a lofty, demanding, and potentially disruptive question. And still, God is doing something here. The light, God's light, is indeed shining in the darkness. I can feel it. I can see it. So, we must engage this difficult question, because the darkness will not

overcome the light.

The opening chapter of the Gospel of John gives us a very honest, but difficult, place to begin wrestling with this question. "¹⁰He was in the world, and the world came into being

through him; yet the world did not know him. ¹¹He came to what was his own, and his own

people did not accept him." (John 1:10-11, NRSV). To honestly begin wrestling with this question of God's action, we must first realize and admit that when God does show up, we have a tendency to not recognize it. And further, we often will work against God's action in the world. This is incredibly

convicting. There is no doubt about that. I, too, am guilty of not recognizing when God shows up. I usually begin by seeing my own accomplishments and work. I try so hard to do good in God's church. But, the more I do this, the more I feel like some imposter. The darkness grows around me; asking questions like, "Am I doing enough?" Our problem with seeing God's action in the world is often that we are so turned inward, we only see our own struggle to do good ourselves. And we are left always wondering, "Is this enough?"

Even more troubling, as God's light begins to shine, it exposes the very darkness we are so keen to hide. Our doubts, concerns, and worries about our lives, our work, our faith, our church, and our world, laid out, exposed to the Ultimate Judge. And when we stand before God, completely and utterly exposed, we know that we have not done good enough. Like I said, John's Gospel: difficult, but honest.

This is where we are in need of some Good News. As we heard at Christmas, "14 And the word became flesh and lived among us... 16 From his fullness we have

all received, grace upon grace." (John 1:14a, 16, NRSV). God does not leave us exposed, in need, and desperate. God does the unthinkable, becomes one of us, a created being, lives among us, and enters our darkness. On the cross, Christ, the fullness of life and light, does not allow darkness to overcome him for us to have the fullness of life and light. This is truly grace upon grace.

Christ cures our darkened hearts by the Holy Spirit residing within us. Giving us the fullness of life and light that darkness cannot overcome. Further, Christ opens our eyes to see the creative work that God is doing, the redeeming work that Christ is doing, and the sustaining work of the Holy Spirit. When we see the work of the church as God's work in us, we are free to participate in the good work without worrying if it will be enough.

This freedom to participate in God's preferred and promised future of the church allows us to wonder and dream. We are freed to wonder and imagine what God might be up to boldly. Because God has promised that God is with us, we

know that God is up to something in and around Calvary Lutheran Church in Federal Way, WA. So, what is God up to in and around this place, this community?

To be honest, I don't have a concrete answer to that question. But I do have a pretty good imagination for what God could be up to. In this New Year, I invite you to imagine with me what God has in store. Maybe, together, we will discover something wonderful that God has already put into motion. But we will never know unless we wonder together.



What's noteworthy?

- In November 2018, income exceeded expenses by \$10,678, decreaing the year-to-date (YTD) operating fund deficit to (\$3,493). Income for the month was much higher than average, while expenses were average.
- YTD income in 2017 was much higher than in 2018 while YTD expenses in 2017 were much lower than in 2018, yielding a large surplus last year and a deficit this year.
