The Gospel Translated

All of [the disciples] were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. Acts 2:4

The second Sunday in June is the Day of Pentecost. It's a day that we Christians celebrate by wearing red, listening to a reading from Acts 2, and celebrating the gift of the Holy Spirit. In years' past, worshipers at Calvary have heard Scripture being broadcast in Mandarin, Norwegian, French, German, Greek, Spanish, and more. A cacophony of languages and sounds, most of which we would fail to differentiate. We Americans tend to rely on non-Americans to speak our language—English, because we depend on it being used globally.

We Christians tend to think similarly. We like to imagine that we speak a global language when we talk about our faith in Jesus. We use Jesus' title, Christ, like it is

Jesus' last name. We talk about Jesus' death and resurrection as a fitting part of the human narrative—as if people die and rise daily. We use words like "disciple" and "gospel" as if they mean the same thing to every Christian, let alone every person. But to some Christians, and almost all people who are not part of the church, this is a foreign language—maybe we should call it Biblese or Christianese.

Speaking the language of the Christian faith is a great thing ... when you have access to the language or, better, have committed it to heart. Using terms like Old Testament or New Testament makes sense if you know how to find each in a Bible. Being able to distinguish between a New Revised Standard Bible and Good News for Modern Man is useful, if you know that both are translations that serve different purposes, and that each has a very different publication date. But for anyone new to the faith, all of this is just jargon—insider language. And where there is insider language, there are viewers who are left outside looking in.

The original Pentecost brings together followers of Jesus, and people who don't have a clue who Jesus is. The narrative gives us a clue about what the Spirit's up to with new believers. (Hint: It's not a common church vocabulary and it's not the right Bible translation.) The Spirit is intent on making sure that the word about Jesus gets out; hearing that God chooses to be for us—not against us; witnessing God work out a loving relationship with the whole creation. Pentecost is about the Spirit providing visitors to Jerusalem direct access to God through the risen Christ.

So what does this have to do with us at Calvary? Well, everything.

Celebrating Pentecost reminds us that God's Spirit shows up to create faith in Christ. People from every nation were in Jerusalem for the Jewish festival of Pentecost, and got more than they had anticipated from Jesus' Galilean disciples—not just some ancient celebration, but actual good news straight via God's Spirit. And that work is what the Spirit plans to do through us as well.

We believers at Calvary may understand ourselves to be as ordinary as those first Galilean disciples—with limited language skills, inadequate training, and finite experience. But if the Spirit can equip those slack-jawed followers with a new language, then the Spirit can certainly breathe into us new and unexpected ways to reach our audience in Federal Way.

But, just as the first gospel preachers were instructed to stay in Jerusalem until they could be "clothed with power from on high" (Luke 24:49) so, this Pentecost, we wait expectantly for Christ's promised Holy Spirit. "Come, Holy Spirit," prays our Leadership Team as we gather on Pente-

cost Sunday afternoon to collaborate about a renewed identity and purpose for our congregation. "Come, Holy Spirit," we pray as a congregation, as we try out new ways of speaking to the community and culture around us—which all too often seems to be speaking in a different language from us.

May we, who seek not only to follow Jesus, but to share his life with the world around us, wait expectantly—ready to be surprised by the Spirit giving our congregation, and each of us, new ways to speak so that others can hear about Christ at work in our world. And may Pentecost be, not just some ancient ritual celebration repeated from the past, but the true work of the Holy Spirit giving us the risen Christ to share in ways we may never before have imagined.

What's noteworthy?

- June's income was much lower than average¹ while expenses were significantly higher than average¹ (partly due to payment of the semi-annual surface water management bill), leading to an operating fund deficit of (\$10,478) for the month and increasing the year-to-date operating deficit to (\$11,433).
 - (1Monthly expenses and income over the last 3 years have averaged \$32,700 to \$33,700).
